Joseph is Accused of Rape and ne goes to Prison (Gen 39:13-23)
Prison 4000 years ago was a bad place—especially for an attractive young man!
21 But the Lord was with Joseph and showed him love and gave him favor in
the sight of the keeper of the prison.
Joseph was a victim of injustice, but he refused to have a victim
Joseph had a robust in the Providence of God
Gen. 50:20 What you meant for, God intended for and the saving of many lives!
Joseph spends much of his young life in slavery and prison (for something he did not do).
Terrible things are done to him over and over, but he continues to in God!
"For we know that God works things together for good to those who love him and are called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28
This story point us to the Greater Joseph
Just like Joseph was betrayed by his brothers and sold for 20 pieces of silver,
Jesus was betrayed by his brothers and sold by Judas for 30 pieces of silver.
Jesus was also in everything he did.

Jesus gets brought up on charges like Joseph
